Risk assessments are the order of the day. With Health and Safety Issues being considered so important, risk analysis has become a necessary requirement in all walks of life. Many complain though that it has all gone too far and restricts the liberty of many, in what would be normal pastimes. Flower arrangements are removed from town centres in case they fall on someone, when it has never happened before. Remembrance Day marches are cancelled, or at least threatened with closure, due to the prohibitive costs of the risk assessments; again for years they have passed off without incident. "Conkers" are banned from school playgrounds and school trips are reduced in number, because of the risks and possible legal action. It always seems that the very worst possible scenario is considered when assessing the risk and deciding on the precautions that have to be taken to manage that perceived risk. Yes, it is all very complicated and costs a lot of money, and finds lucrative employment for many "risk assessors"

Everything is done to protect our bodies from the risk of injury or even death, things of which people are really afraid. The "Nanny State" tries to put us all in "cotton wool" and provide as much
