It has become very clear to us who have been praying so much during this pandemic how hard it has been to make progress and how strong the things are against which we pray and it has appeared at some times that we have failed altogether in our requests.

The Lord spoke to us at the beginning of the pandemic that this has been allowed to show to the developed countries that they are not in control and that He would have mercy on the poor and the needy, and that has worked out in the results of what has happened worldwide. He that sits in the heavens shall laugh: The Lord shall have them in derision. Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath and vex them in his sore displeasure.

So, as we pray, the immensity of the task to bring the change we seek becomes more and more clear. We want God to move and the show His almighty power and give a testimony to His people. We ask Him to bring this pandemic to an end, so it is clear God has moved. So, we see the power of darkness, it has its hour and is the work of him who comes to steal, kill, and destroy and yet the first promise in the Bible says, "The seed of the woman shall bruise the serpent's head". In other words, there will be a human being who will defeat satan, the enemy of all people. It will be through a human being!!!!

The thought is amazing, the promise immense declaring that the victory could come through one man. This when we are aware of how strong the spiritual things are against which we fight and wrestle in these times and which have caused the nations to rage and oppose God since sin arrived in the world.

His NAME IS JESUS. O How great He is and how marvellous are His works. He did the work as one human being. Many are praying at this time and we fight on and will gain the victory, but we read that this one man, after He had once offered Himself for our sins, sat down on the throne of the majesty on high. Jesus died for the sins of the whole world. He took on Him the sin of us all. He was bruised for our transgressions; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him and by His stripes we are healed. Wonderful, O so very wonderful; this one offering was enough for all people for all time.

This declares the immensity of His godliness, His holiness, His faith, His sacrifice, and His love. Jesus openly defeated all the powers of darkness in His death, in weakness, on the cross. We see how strong they are, but Jesus broke their power, out in the light where spiritually it could all be seen and known. Jesus, then in complete control of life and death: He offered Himself to God. Yes it is hard work, Jesus sweated great drops of blood, but we continue even when everything seems so impossible. Abraham believed when all hope was gone and received the promise. Paul prayed and when all hope was God worked. So, we pray and will prevail because the seed of the woman has bruised the serpent's head. The man Jesus Christ overcame and is Lord of all.
